Re: COVID-19 Update

This week we started following the new guidelines for employee COVID -19 testing.

As a reminder,

*If a resident goes out of the community for a medical appointment or other purpose, they will be quarantined to their room upon return for a period of 3 days per Millview policy

*If you are doing a window visit at Millview with family or friends we still must maintain the social distance of 6 feet and both residents and visitor must wear face masks if the window is open. If you are coming to Millview for such a visit and do not have a mask, please ring our doorbell and we will provide you with one.

*** Please remind your love ones to wear their provided mask when leaving their rooms out in our community for everyone's safety.**

*If a resident has a confirmed positive case of covid-19 or there is a resident death due to COVID -19 we will notify you and your family within 24 hours of such.

We are very happy to see that phase one of re-opening will begin in Albany County this week. Health care facilities have been designated for re-opening in the last phase. At this time, we do not have a time frame as to when this might be, but we anxiously await the day that we can open our community to you.

We are encouraging our residents to enjoy the nice weather in our courtyard.
