Re: COVID and Community Updates

**We are moving our visitation program inside starting Monday November 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

These visits will be offered in our community room down stairs. An area will be set up similar to our outside patio visitation area to meet all the guidelines for our COVID-19 Visitation Plan approved by the Department of Health.

Anyone who signs up for a visit starting November 2, is required to drive down the back of our building and enter Millview at our Community Room entrance, this will limit visitor access to our Community. Please call the facility when you arrive for someone to meet you.

**\*To ensure maximum comfort of residents and visitors all window visits will stop on November 2, and the only visitation allowed will be scheduled visits in the community room**

You may still drop items off at any time for residents by ringing our doorbell.

Please note a few key items in our visitation plan that must be followed per DOH guidelines:

- Only 2 visitors are allowed per resident
- Social distancing and face masks are required during the visit ( no food is allowed to be consumed at the visit)
- Millview staff must be available to supervise the visit
- You must call the Activity department on Mondays to schedule a visit for that week only

**There is still a significant number of residents going out of our community for personal reasons, please consider when planning to go out that this potentially opens our community to exposure with each outing and residents will be subject to a three day room quarantine upon return.**

**For medical needs that do not require in person contact we are still setting up telemed visits for our Residents**

**If you must go out please continue to practice social distancing and wear a face mask even with family members.**

We continue to report daily to the Department of Health on the COVID status of our Community. Many groups are advocating to the State for Assisted Living visitation and we will readily adapt to any new mandates or guidelines they provide to us.
