Re: Millview Community update and COVID

We are excited that our community has received its second dose of COVID Vaccine on 2/10/21. 97% of the residents were vaccinated and 68% of the staff. There are a few people that will receive their second dose of vaccine on March 3rd

We went into a room quarantine period on 2/14/21 due to a positive COVID case however working with Department of Health our community was able to come out of quarantine on 2/18/21.

Due to the vaccination of our residents and staff and the decrease in cases of COVID in Albany County, we will open our visitation program again on 2/23/21 following our visitation policy. We have revised our visitation days and will no longer be offering visitation on Wednesdays. Visitation will be offered on Tuesday, Thursday and Sundays in allocated time slots.

We have also revised our room quarantine period for residents going out of our building for doctor appointments from 7 days to 4 days effective 2/22/21.

We still continue to encourage telemed medicine .

*Please note the department of health has not changed the quarantine period for residents going to the hospital or new admissions, it remains at 14 days.

*In addition, the holiday or personal outing requirements for our residents that Department of Health put in place at Thanksgiving still remains in effect at this time.

Our Adult Home Association continues to advocate for changes to the Department of Health mandates regarding community visitation and personal outings for our residents, especially in light of vaccinations that have occurred in health care facilities. We will continue to update you to any changes.
