Re: Covid-19 Community Updates

Good News!!! Department of Health has ended their holiday visitation mandates effective now.

If you helped us advocate for changes – Thank you!!!!

This means residents are able to go out for social or personal visits in addition to medical visits and return to Millview with just a COVID screening upon re-entry.

In addition there will be no quarantine placed on the resident upon re-entry to Millview for personal or medical appointments.

The 14 day quarantine still remains in effect if you are returning from a hospital or for a new admission to Millview.

We have to continue to maintain small group activities, less than 10 and ensure social distancing and face masks for residents out in the community.

We will continue our current visitation program in the community room or outside with designated times and must stop visitation whenever a resident or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 for 14 days, except for compassionate care visits. Advocacy efforts continue and we do anticipate visitation changes in the near future.

As a resident reminder, you do need to sign in and out when leaving and returning to Millview.
