Re: Community COVID update

We are so happy to see we are making progress in the our State with COVID- 19 regulations and that we have seen some progress with the Adult Home regulations .

As you have been made aware a new regulation was passed allowing residents during any public health emergency to designate up to two people to be Compassionate Caregiver Visitors and up to two people to be Personal Care Visitors that will be allowed access if we have mandated visitation restrictions. All residents have designated individuals for these roles and may change their designee at any time.

In addition, Employees and medical providers who are fully vaccinated, (10 days since the last vaccination dose), do not have to test weekly for COVID- 19 anymore unless they are symptomatic or exposed to someone with COVID-19. Any employee, medical provider or vendor that are not fully vaccinated will need to continue to be COVID tested weekly.

No changes have been made yet to mask wearing or social distancing in the community or dining. Activities are still limited to 10 people.

As a reminder we have updated our community visitation program to 5 days a week at the times designated below. These times are specific to avoid meal service times as we still have two dining sessions at each meal. Your cooperation and understanding are greatly appreciated at adhering to these times.

**9:00am start time to 11:00am end time**

**1pm start time to 3:15pm end time**
